Duties and Responsibilities

• To maintain strict vigilance to prevent any kind of ragging activities within the campus and hostel.

- To handle complaints and incidents related to ragging promptly and confidentially.
- To spread awareness among students about the consequences of ragging.
- To coordinate with local authorities and take disciplinary action when necessary.
- To ensure support and counseling for affected students.
